Christian Zanotto is amongst the artists invited to exhibit at “**Acqua è - 100 artists for one planet**”, a **great international art exhibition** that will be hosted from the **17th of September till the 31st of October 2015** at **Expo Venice Aquae Pavilion**.

The exhibition has been conceived and organized by Giampaolo Prearo, founder of the famous Milan art publishing house **Prearo Editore**, in **collaboration with Willy Montini and ArtCom**; the show is curated by **Vera Agosti and Gianni Floris** and **presents artworks inspired by and dedicated to the theme “water”**: **more than 100 Italian and international artists**, great masters and young talents, displayed along a very articulate expositive itinerary with a strong visual and emotional impact. Paintings, sculptures, photos, videos and installations will lead the visitor on a journey through visions which deal, by means of different styles, feelings and creative methods, with the multiple facets of the subject “water”, vital element for excellence, precious and primordial, here investigated through a great variety of symbolic readings.

“**Acqua è**” is a unique exhibition that for the first time compares different expressions of the art world united under a single denominator, water; the artworks of the hundred invited artists, between which internationally renowned names stand out, perfectly respond to the theme of the **Universal Exposition of 2015 "Feeding the Planet, Energy for Life"**: water and life are all along joined in an ancestral, instinctive and indissoluble binomial.

“**Acqua è**”, collective show of great depth, started from a project of 2008 and finds now in **Aquae Pavilion** its natural 'habitat' in **Venice, the city of water** par excellence, in the brand new multi-purpose space designed by the architect **Michele de Lucchi**.

Prearo Editore and **Marsilio Editori** will publish on the occasion of the event an **extensive catalogue** that will be presented at Expo Venice within the 30th of September 2015.
